3. Access to the ECC carpark is only from Injune Way - there is no direct access from Joondalup Drive.

Train

Travel to ECU's Joondalup campus via the Perth Underground Station taking the **Butler** train line to Joondalup Station. Once you arrive at the Joondalup Station, walk or take the bus to the ECU campus.

Walk

Walking at a normal pace, it takes 20-25 minutes to walk from Joondalup Station to Edith Cowan College.

Bus

Take the free **Red**¹ CAT bus that departs from Stand 8 at Joondalup Station. Get off at Stop 3 'University Drive' and get on ECU's dedicated Hop on Hop Off Shuttle Bus service which operates between the main **Joondalup Campus and Edith Cowan College** on a continuous basis between 07.30 and 18.00 Monday to Friday. The bus has signage to indicate that it is a 'Hop on Hop Off' service around the Joondalup Campus to **Edith Cowan College**.

¹The Red CAT does not operate on the weekend or on public holidays.

On Saturday, there are no CAT buses so take the 465² bus from Joondalup Station, Stand 7 (Stop Number 17851) to Joondalup Drive (after Grand Boulevard, stop number 17781). For safety, cross to the other side of the road at the lights, and walk 350m to **Edith Cowan College**. Look for the signs to the main entrance.

²The 465 bus leaves Joondalup Station every 20-30 minutes.

The **Yellow** CAT is an evening service and operates **during semester from 6pm**, Monday to Thursday. There is a stop outside the Library (Building 31) on the main ECU Joondalup Campus.

Car

Edith Cowan College is at the intersection of Joondalup Drive and Injune Way. If travelling to ECU via the Mitchell Freeway, take either the Hodges Drive, **or** Ocean Reef Road exit.

From Hodges Drive exit:

Turn right onto Joondalup Drive and then at the next traffic lights, turn right onto Sundew Rise, right at the roundabout onto Honeybrush Drive, right again onto Injune Way and then left into **Edith Cowan College**.

From Ocean Reef Road exit:

Turn left onto Joondalup Drive and drive for approximately 2.5km (north towards ECU campus). Turn left onto Injune Way and then a quick right into **Edith Cowan College**.

During semester, the car parks and roads around the campus are very busy. There is small number of **green Visitor parking spots** at **Edith Cowan College**. You need to purchase a ticket. It costs \$1.50 per hour and can be paid with PayPass or coins. The machine does not give change so you need to have the correct money for about 4 hours – 3 hours for the test and some extra time for the security check and finding the room etc. Visitor parking is free on Saturday. **Do not park in front of the café and other shops; you risk being fined and/or having your car clamped.**
